This is a summary of how our school delivers music education to all our pupils across three areas – curriculum music, co-curricular provision and musical experiences – and what changes we are planning in future years. This information is to help pupils and parents or carers understand what our school offers and who we work with to support our pupils' music education.

Part A: Curriculum music

This is about what we teach in lesson time, how much time is spent teaching music and any music qualifications or awards that pupils can achieve.

Disley Primary School follows Music Express Online (further information can be found on the link below). Music Express Online is based on the model music curriculum.

Music Express Online allows for whole class teaching where pupils learn to sing or play an instrument during lesson time.

Disley Primary School engage with the Love Music Trust who deliver two terms of music provision each year for year 5, where the children get the opportunity to learn to play an instrument and sing.

Part B: Co-curricular music

This is about opportunities for pupils to sing and play music, outside of lesson time, including choirs, ensembles and bands, and how pupils can make progress in music beyond the core curriculum.

Disley Primary School provides the annual opportunity for children to engage with an extra-curricular choir where they learn to sing a range of songs together.

Peripatetic teachers come in to Disley Primary School and offer subsidised lessons for pupils. Currently Disley Primary School offers:

- Drums
- Violin
- Piano
- Brass
- Guitar

Part C: Musical experiences

This is about all the other musical events and opportunities that we organise, such as singing in assembly, concerts and shows, and trips to professional concerts.

The pupils at Disley Primary School get to engage with the following musical experiences:

- Productions across the year for all year groups (harvest, nativities and the summer performance)
- All children have the opportunity to go to the theatre annually to watch a pantomime
- Regular musical concerts are held to showcase the progress children make in their playing of instruments
- In year 5, the children have the opportunity to attend the Bridgewater Hall and play their instrument alongside the Halle orchestra
- Our school choir has the opportunity to perform at varying local areas including Lymme Park and the Christmas Light Switch on in the village
- Children engage with music workshops
- Volunteers come in and deliver musical opportunities for our reception children

In the future

Disley Primary School would like to engage with the Love Music Trust and alternate musical opportunities each year through the offer of learning to play a different instrument.

Disley Primary School would like to offer a wider range of instruments to play in music lessons taught across the school.
