PSHE: Create a poster titled What Makes Me, Me? Draw a picture of yourself and write things about yourself around the outside. Take a careful look at the world around you and find a landscape you think is interesting and/or beautiful. Take a picture of the landscape and create a sketch from the picture. Humanities: Choose one of the biomes we have been learning about (aquatic, grassland, forest, desert and tundra) and present a poster on the features.	Maths: Complete 20 minutes a week on Times Table Rock Stars.	RE: Research a religious celebration and present the findings in a format of your choice
Reading/Phonics: Make a presentation or poster about your favourite book. Make sure to include the book's title, author's name, a brief blurb and an explanation of why you like the book.
